“Sasayuri Support Class’s” Promises

『学習支援教室ささゆり』の約束

1. Come directly to class, and go straight home afterwards.
行(い)き帰(かえ)りは、寄(よ)り道(みち)しない。
2. Please come to class by 2pm, and give your teacher 200yen.
教室(きょうしつ)へは、14 時(じ)までに入(はい)り、先生(せんせい)に 200 円(えん)わたす。
3. If you will be late, or cannot come, please let us know. (080-3287-2636)
おくれるときや、欠席(けっせき)するときは、連絡(れんらく)【080-3287-2636】する。
4. Wear your name tag during class.
教室(きょうしつ)では、名札(なふだ)をつける。
5. Pay attention to what your teacher is saying.
先生(せんせい)の話(はなし)を、しっかり聞(き)く。
6. Concentrate during class. Do not chat with other students.
勉強中(べんきょうちゅう)は、おしゃべりをせずに集中(しゅうちゅう)する。
7. Do not distract your friends while they are studying.
友達(ともだち)の勉強(べんきょう)をじゃましない。
8. Do not bring any sweets or toys with you to class.
お菓子(かし)や遊(あそ)び道具(どうぐ)は持(も)ってこない。
9. Do not use electronic devices such as smartphones in the classroom except for study purposes.
スマホは、勉強(べんきょう)以外(いがい)では、使(つか)わない。
10. Do not leave class without telling a teacher.
勝手(かって)に 教室(きょうしつ)から出(で)ない。
11. Give the contact card to someone at home.
ささゆり連絡(れんらく)カードは 家(いえ)の人(ひと)に渡(わた)して、次(つぎ)来(く)るときに持(も)ってくる。
12. Parents or guardians of the participants are responsible for their safety on their way to and from class.
